





The project was implemented with the support of the Norilsk City Administration and PJSC "MMC Norilsk Nickel".

The study is aimed at assessing the development potential in four key areas: infrastructure modernization, environmental sustainability (including the "Sulfur Project"), development of the creative potential of residents, and economic diversification. The project brought together government bodies, businesses, and experts to create a modern urban environment.

Study "Public Spaces of Northern Cities"

scope of the study -141 cities with a total population of 9.5 million inhabitants

The study is aimed at examining the features of the formation and functioning of all types of public spaces in the conditions of the Far North and equivalent territories.

During the study, the functional features of open and closed spaces, the spatial organization of public space systems, and key formation factors (climatic, urban planning, socio-demographic, and sociocultural) were analyzed.

The study allowed to identify problems caused by unique conditions and form a comprehensive understanding of the development trends of public spaces in the Far North.

The territory analysis allowed for the development of optimal solutions for combining sports and leisure functions while preserving the historical context.







During the study, infrastructure development scenarios, event programs, and educational initiatives were developed, adopting global best practices.





The master plan is aimed at transforming the city into a modern transport and logistics BAM hub. It includes a development program until 2030 aimed at renovation, gasification, infrastructure modernization, and tourism development.

Conceptual Master Plan for the City of Svobodny, Amur Region

As part of the master plan development, a socio-economic and spatial analysis of the city was conducted, during which trends, traditions, and potential of the macroregion were studied, and promising development scenarios were identified.

As a result, long and short lists of key projects were formed, including activities for the construction of significant social infrastructure, leisure and entertainment, and innovative facilities, as well as the development of the industrial sector based on gas-chemical production. The master plan is aimed at the comprehensive development of the city of Svobodny as a key BAM hub.

The project was initiated by the Andrey Melnichenko Charity Foundation. The master plan was developed with the support of the Government of the Republic of Khakassia and JSC "SUEK-KHAKASSIA".




Open international competition for the development of an architectural concept for the G. Kamal Tatar State Academic Theatre

500 participants from 28 cities and 19 countries, 8 finalists

The competition partnered were the Government of the Republic of Tatarstan, the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Tatarstan, the Kazan Mayor's Office, and the Galiasgar Kamal Tatar State Academic Theatre. The goal of the competition was to develop an architectural concept for the new state theater building, the project of the surrounding public spaces, and the integration of the entire complex into the system of the Kaban Lakes embankments.

The Russian-Japanese consortium headed by Wowhaus Architectural Bureau (Moscow, Russia) won the competition. The consortium also includes Kengo Kuma & Associates (Tokyo, Japan), Werner Sobek AG (Stuttgart, Germany), and Architect German Alekseevich Bakulin's PTM (Kazan, Russia).

The project was implemented in 2024.



Open International Competition for the development of an architectural and planning renovation concept for the city of Norilsk up to 2035

70 participants from 22 cities and 13 countries, 5 finalists

The competition was held with the support of ANO "Center for Territorial Development" and PJSC "MMC Norilsk Nickel".

The aim of the competition is to select the best architectural and urban planning concept for renovation of the city of Norilsk until 2035, defining the optimum parameters and solutions for the city development in accordance with modern approaches to architecture, urban planning and urban technology.




Open Nationwide Competition for the Design of the Redevelopment Concept for the Main Building of the Izhevsk Arms Factory

The competition was held with the support of the Government of the Udmurt Republic and the Administration of the city of Izhevsk. The aim is to choose the best redevelopment concept with a change in functional purpose for the landmark object in the Republic's capital with a status of cultural heritage monument of federal importance. The uniqueness of the competition lies in the fact that the winner produced a detailed redevelopment concept in the form of a sketch restoration project and a package of accompanying documents necessary to pass a state examination.

Open Nationwide Competition for the development of standard designs with the use of wooden load-bearing structures

The competition was held upon the instructions of the Government of the Russian Federation with the support of the Ministry of Construction of Russia, the Ministry of Industry and Trade of Russia, and the Association of Wooden Housing Construction.

The competition is aimed at creation of a database of standard designs for detached houses and apartment buildings (up to 4 stories), as well as for social and cultural facilities with the use of wooden load-bearing structures; search for approaches to designing low-rise residential developments, apartment blocks, and private houses, the integration of the best practices in the use of wooden load-bearing structures into the current and future development of urban and rural settlements. As a result of the competition, an open library of standard designs was formed.

The founders of the Biennale are the Government of the Republic of Tatarstan and the Ministry of Construction, Housing and Utilities of the Russian Federation, and the organizing committee is the "Institute for the Cities of the Republic of Tatarstan" Foundation.

The Third Russian Youth Architecture Biennale was established to create a gold reserve of architects for the whole of Russia and to provide the young generation with a real opportunity to be noticed and heard in the profession.

The key topic of the Biennale is the search for a new workspace philosophy, including an architectural concept, design solutions and user scenarios for a new workplace.




